- Initiatives to combat poverty, provide healthy food, and assist with job training imperiled
- Affordable housing development reduced
- Elimination of housing and community development programs and services
- More vulnerable people facing eviction
- Increase in the number people entering the shelter system
- Less money raised money for our communities
