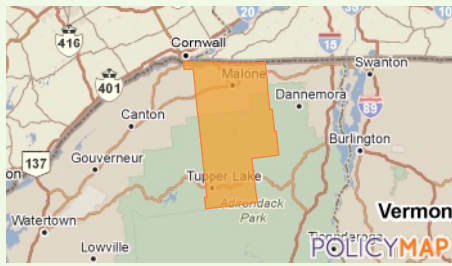

Racial Characteristics:

Of the people living in this area in between 2011-2015, 82.98% are White, 5.57% are African American, 3.27% are Hispanic, 0.43% are Asian, 0.01% are either Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, 7.23% are American Indian or Alaskan Native, 1.65% are of "some other race" and 2.13% are of two or more races. In the table below, the percentage of the population that each segment represents in the report area is compared to the percent it represents in the state.

Between 2000 and 2011-2015, the White population changed by -1.99%, the African American population by -8.2%, and Asian population by 229.85%. The number of Hispanics changed by -18.45%.

Incomes:

The median household income for the study area was \$47,923, compared to the state of New York with a median of \$59,269, as estimated for 2011-2015 by the Census' American Community Survey.

The number of households divided by income categories is shown in the Annual Income Category table. In 2015, 51.97% of households in the study area had an annual income of less than \$50,000, compared to 43.4% of people in the state of New York.

Immigration:

Data from the U.S. Census Bureau for 2011-2015 indicate that 1,940 people or 3.78% of the population living in this area were "foreign born". Census defines foreign born as anyone who is not a U.S. citizen at birth. This area is located in New York, which, according to the Department of Homeland Security, was home to 130,010 people who were granted Legal Permanent Residence status in 2015. Those LPRs, or "green cards", represent 12.37% of green cards issued in the nation that year.

Families and Households:

The composition of the 12,202 families who reside in the study area is shown in the table below. Families are groups of related people who live together, whereas households refer to the person or group of people living in any one housing unit. Generally, households that do not contain a family are made up of unrelated people living together (eg, roommates) or people living alone. While it is possible for two families to share a household, the difference between the number of households and the number of families in an area shows, approximately, the number of non-family households in a place.

Housing Type:

Tenure:

Across the area, an estimated 72.73% or 13,927 households owned their home between 2011-2015. The average size of a household in this area was 2.36 between 2011-2015, as compared to the average household size for the county and the state, 2.36 (Franklin) and 2.63 (New York) respectively.

There were an estimated 25,293 housing units in the study area in 2011-2015, according to the Census' American Community Survey. For 2011-2015, the Census showed an estimated 24.3% of housing units to be vacant, compared to 11.13% in the state of New York.

Endnotes:

Calculations presented here were performed by staff at PolicyMap and are based on public and proprietary data sources.

Depending on the type of size of the area selected for this report, the above values capture data for the block groups, tracts, counties, etc, in which at least 50% of their areas are contained. If this report is run for a zip code, some data will be unavailable, as zip code values for some topics are not available.

For custom areas, such as radii, custom regions, school districts, and political districts, Census ACS data was calculated by summing the following component County in 2000: Franklin, and the following component County in 2011-2015: Franklin.

Any change calculations included in this report reflect PolicyMap's translation of boundary changes from 2000 to 2010. Therefore, they may not match a calculation done using the 2000 and 2011-2015 values shown in the report.

Estimates of tenure, incomes, and housing stock are provided by the ACS for 2011-2015. Data on legal permanent residents is from the Department of Homeland Security, and, for all areas, describes the state in which that area is located.
