



# The Impact of New York State Neighborhood Preservation Companies

In 2019, Neighborhood Preservation Companies (NPCs) across New York State served our urban and suburban communities by providing services and activities in affordable housing, community development, and financial empowerment. NPCs are funded through the Neighborhood Preservation Program of New York State Homes and Community Renewal (NYSHCR).

**6,737** evictions prevented

**8,081** units of housing rehabilitated

**4,999** new units of housing constructed



**19,113** people in special populations assisted

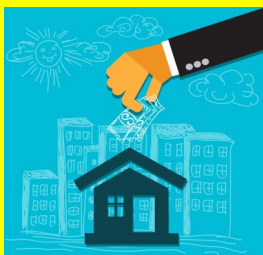
**6,293** individuals served by neighborhood and block associations
