Senate/Assembly One-house Budget Bill Phone Script

Guidelines:

Identify yourself and explain your relationship with the Legislator. Then, ask to speak with

her/him.

You may be transferred to the Legislator's phone line, to talk with her/him or be instructed to

leave a message. Alternately, a staffer may ask to take a message.

Whether leaving a message, or if connected, reintroduce yourself.

When finished, don't forget a message of thanks for the time.

[Phone rings]

Staffer/Receptionist: Hello, Senator/Assemblymember's office, how may I assist you?

You: Hi, my name is Name from Organization, and I'm calling as a constituent from Legislator's

District. May I speak with Senator/Assemblymember Name about the budget bill and its impact

on neighborhood preservation?

**Staffer/Receptionist:** May I ask what this is regarding?

You: Yes, of course. Organization is part of the Neighborhood Preservation Coalition,

a network of 130 community nonprofits providing critical housing assistance. We're on the

frontlines helping New Yorkers who are at risk of housing instability, and I'm calling to talk to

Senator/Assemblymember Name about the Senate's/Assembly's budget bill.

**Staffer/Receptionist:** I see. Please hold for a moment.

(You're placed on hold and either connected to the legislator or an aide.)

Legislator or Aide: Hello, this is Legislator, Staff, speaking. How can I assist you?

You: Hello Legislator/Aide's Name, my name is Name from Organization, and I appreciate you taking the time to speak with me today. I'm calling to express my gratitude for the Senate's/
Assembly's budget bill, which reinstates \$18.3 million in funding for the Neighborhood
Preservation Program (NPP) and includes the \$250,000 carve-out for the Coalition

**Legislator or Aide:** How can I help?

**You:** Your efforts has been instrumental in addressing the significant deficit proposed in the Governor's budget, which would have cut our funding by 30%. Additionally, you've also recognized the need to account for the program's 6% cost-of-expense increase.

Aide or Legislator: We understand . . .

**You:** Senator/Assemblymember Name, this critical funding is the lifeline that enables the Coalition to bolster our neighborhood preservation companies across the state, ensuring they continue to thrive and serve our communities. We urge you to stand firm in budget negotiations to ensure this funding remains intact, as it is vital to preserving neighborhoods across the state.

If Aide: Thank you for calling. We will share this with Senator/Assemblymember's Name.

If Legislator: They will respond accordingly.

**You:** We appreciate your leadership and continued support for the Neighborhood Preservation Program. Thank you for your time.

Aide: Thank you. Have a great day.

You: You too. Goodbye.
